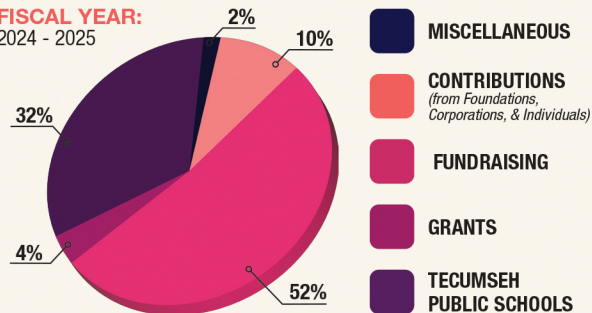


- CLC has been in partnership with Tecumseh Public Schools for more than 30 years. We are a non-profit that works within the schools, but are our own separate entity.
- CLC provides services for all TPS Students (*Preschool to 12th*) and their families.
- We have our own board that includes 3 THS Students with voting power.
- CLC staff works closely with TPS Administration, Staff, & Counselors to make sure we are covering any student needs that may arise. CLC will always confirm student services are needed by both the school and their family.
- CLC relies on monetary support from individuals in the community, businesses, local grants, and fundraising efforts to provide much needed programming.
- \$1,000 provides 10 girls the ability to participate in our ROX program.
- \$500 allows 1 family to attend our Getting Ahead classes that assists them with removing the barriers of generational financial hardship. This includes dinner & childcare during the class.
- \$100 provides 30 Friday Food Packs to our food insecure students. We are currently servicing more than 120 students weekly.

Throughout the 2025 fiscal year (October 1, 2024 - September 30, 2025) Community Learning Connections raised \$198,410.56 due to the generous support from our community, grants, and fundraisers! Tecumseh Public Schools (TPS) plays a vital role in reducing our expenses by offering office space, technology, and other services in-kind, guaranteeing that your contributions directly benefit student services.
